#### **Preface**

It's a matter of great pleasure to place the annual report 2016-17 before the Hon'ble Management of Vidya Bharati Shaikshnik Mandal, Amravati regarding the various activities conducted for the all round development of students and various facilities newly developed to undertake quality initiatives in academics and achievements in research, games and sports and cultural activities. Besides, due to timely support of the management infrastructural changes could have been brought in.

I am very happy and feel proud to record here that the college has been achieving laurels and coming up with flying colours in the field of academics, games and sports, curricular and extra-curricular, research and social outreach activities. I feel all these achievements are the results of work as a team, the dedication and commitment of the faculty.

In this academic session 2016-17 the college has achieved every possible success in all aspects of academics. We have become successful in focusing the learner-centric activities. As far as research is concerned we have 27 research supervisors who are actively engaged in research. As a result of this on an average we could produce 93 successful Ph.D scholars in the last 05 years. This year too we have produced 15 research students and 03 faculty members with Ph.D degree. In short, research is rigorously and qualitatively carried out here. In this academic year our 02 faculty members and 11 PG students have cleared NET/SET examination.

In the opening of the academic year around 3000 students got enrolled for various UG and PG programmes. The students who appeared for University examination Summer-2016 have achieved commendable success i.e. on an average the university examination results are found more than 70%. This year our 23 students appeared in the general Merit List of the University. Two of them grabbed Gold Medals. Beside their academic achievements they are not lagging behind in Co-curricular and Extra-curricular activities. Our 55 students brought laurels in different competitions testing their soft skills. 06 students took part in Avishkar-2016, bagged Ist Prize and all of them got University Colour Coats, 08 students brought Colour Coats in Youth Festival-2016. Our students are at the best when it comes to their achievements in Games and Sports are concerned. 29 of them have brought University Colour Coats in different competitions of Games and Sports. In short, this year our students have brought 43 colour coats which indicate the richness of the campus.

I am extremely happy to mention that the 'Training and Placement Cell' could find out jobs for 35 students in Multinational Companies. In order to open Administrative

Avenues for our students, the college has set up an active MPSC Cell from this academic year so as to enable our students to enter the administration.

The college has started Social Outreach and Enabling Centre (SOEC) from this year as a part of commitment to the society. This centre comprises of 'Pratibha Women's Studies Centre', 'Enviro-Club' and 'Yog Sadhana Kendra'. The centre is completely dedicated to the various issues and hence it undertook sensitization programmes and programmes for Environmental Awareness etc.

For inculcating the moral values among the youths a drama called 'Krantyogi Gadgebaba' depicting the life story of Sant Gadgebaba was staged in the A.V.Theatre of the college.

Throughout the year different departments have conducted various academic and learner-centric activities and thereby extended a helping hand for every possible progress of the students. In the month of September State Level Elocution Competition was organized as a regular feature of the campus. The Internal Quality Assurance Cell of the college has organized Two Day National Seminar on 'Attaining Excellence in Higher Education...' in the month of October. Besides, a National Conference on 'Smart India Vision-2020' was organized by Dept.of Management Studies. The Research and Co-ordination Committee under IQAC has conducted One Day Workshop on 'Research Methodology', another Workshop on 'Restructuring of Syllabi in Physics' was also held in the month of January. In addition to this different workshops on such as 'Teaching Techniques', 'ICT Proficiency', 'Cashless India...', One Day Book Exhibition, Rare Stamp Collection Exhibition, Subject wise Guest Lectures, Invited Talks, Paper Cutting Exhibition, inauguration of Vidya Niketan Study Center, College level Competitive Examination, Debate, Elocution, Quiz and Essay Writing Competitions etc. have been conducted meticulously.

I am proud of our faculty members for their hard work and unfailing bond with the institution and the students, their dedicated innovative Teaching-Learning Practices, Research activities and continuous support in administration. They have successfully guided Research Scholars and produced 15 students with Ph.D.Degree. 29 Teachers have published their quality Research papers in National and International Journals of great repute. 41 Teachers have published their papers in the proceedings of various conferences and Symposia. 78 Teachers have participated in Conferences, Seminars and Workshops. They have been continuously extended their academic services to the University in the form of Examination Work, Restructuring of Syllabi and by being the component of Authorities of the University.

Two of our faculty members have gone abroad in the countries like Croatia and Vienna, Austria for representing the college at International Forum.

With the wholehearted support of the management the college could have bring in some infrastructural changes in the form of Cafeteria, Vidya Niketan Study Center, cultivated play-field, LED street lights, CCTV, Renovation of Laboratories and Building for Self-Financing Courses etc.




